Admission procedure	Students from our partner universities interested in exchange studies for a semester or full year at <b>IUT2 Grenoble</b> have to be nominated by their home universities to start the admission procedure. Only nominated students through the <a href="#">nomination portal</a> or by email to <a href="mailto:iut2-sri@univ-grenoble-alpes.fr">iut2-sri@univ-grenoble-alpes.fr</a> will be accepted. Nominated students receive a generated email from the International Office to start the application process. For admission, students have to complete our online application form in time and provide us with all necessary documents.

The courses are offered in collaboration with a local University Center of French Studies (CUEF) and free of cost for all exchange students. In addition, our International Office also offers language practice with our local students through the Buddy program. Students also have the support of volunteers that we host every year within the framework of the European Solidarity Corps for extracurricular activities.</p>

## HOUSING

Students can choose between two kinds of accommodation: university residences (public or private) and the private rental sector. **For exchange students who apply for residencies in the public sector:** they automatically receive credentials by email, allowing them to access the online housing application platform. Students who meet the deadlines will receive an offer of accommodation from the International Students & Scholars Office (ISSO).

## IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

<a href="#">VISAS AND RESIDENCE PERMITS</a>	<p>Except for nationals of a European Economic Area country (European Union country (EU), Iceland, Norway and Liechtenstein) or Switzerland, students coming to study for more than 3 months must apply for a visa.
